

Where to find advice?

The passenger is responsible for choosing the right travel ticket. Therefore, mainly before your first journey in the system, please pay special attention to the selection of the zones or the time length of your journey. In case you need more information you can find it at all points of sale, in ZSSK information centers or via telephone and internet contacts of BID.

When travelling **by city public transport** you have to buy the ticket before your journey and validate it immediately after entering the vehicle. If you are buying the ticket **from the driver** when entering the **Regiobus** you have to tell him the name of the bus stop where you want to get off. If you are planning to continue in your journey by changing, then you should tell the driver the number of the zone you are travelling to, possibly also the name of your destination stop. If you are getting on the bus with an already purchased and stamped ticket, show it to the driver and inform him which stop you want get off at. If your ticket needs to be stamped, don't forget to do so. The driver will register your destination stop and he will give you an information receipt about your route. In the event of a ticket inspection you are obliged to legitimize yourself with the travel ticket.

**When traveling by train** we recommend you to buy the ticket in advance. Tickets bought from the train conductor on board of the train have a surcharge added to their standard price. An exception, when the surcharge isn't added, applies if you get on the train at a station without an opportunity to buy a ticket. Both when buying the ticket in a ticket office or from the train conductor, it's enough to know your destination stop or zone of your journey.

The combination of IDS BK tickets with ZSSK train tickets

You can combine IDS BK tickets with ZSSK tickets. IDS BK tickets are valid only on trains of categories Os and REX. A ZSSK ticket is valid only if the starting point is a station in which the train you are travelling on stops according to the timetable. Therefore it isn't possible to combine tickets in a station, where the train doesn't stop.

*Example:*  
*You are travelling by train from Bratislava to Malacky and you want to use your ticket valid for zones 100+ 101 and for the rest of the journey you want to buy a ZSSK ticket from Devínske Jazero (last station in zone 100 on the line). If, however, you are making the same journey by a REX train, you have to buy the train ticket already from Devínska Nová Ves, whereas the REX trains don't stop at Devínske Jazero.*

Travelcards

With a Travelcard you can make an unlimited number of journeys within its zone and time validity. Travelcards are non-transferable between passengers. They are sold only electronically on to an accepted smart card.

Travelling without a valid ticket

Travelling without a valid ticket doesn't pay off. If you are not able to legitimize yourself with a valid ticket in the event of a ticket inspection, you are obliged to pay the fare plus a fine which can reach up to 70 €, or legitimize yourself with your ID or passport with personal information necessary for claiming the fine.

Discounted fare, Sales points

The IDS BK provides commercial and social discounts. Commercial discounts are given on Travelcards, or a 10 % discount is given when paying for the ticket with the credit on your smart card.

- Persons with the right for a social discount:
- » children from 6 years until the completion of 16 years of age,
  - » students of primary and secondary schools and full time university students,
  - » holders of a Slovak ID proving they are severely disabled,
  - » pensioners from 60 years, who have a special ID,
  - » persons older than 62 years.

More discounts are provided for selected groups of citizens with a permanent residence in the Bratislava region.

offer a complete selection of travel tickets except a Karnet ticket.

**Ticket offices of Dopravný podnik Bratislava**  
offer a complete selection of Day Tickets, Travelcards, Single tickets valid in 2 or up to 5 zones and Karnet ticket.

**Ticket machines at railway stations and in shopping centers**  
offer a complete selection of travel tickets except Karnet ticket.

**Ticket machines at bus stops**  
offer a selection of Single Tickets and Day Tickets.

**Newagents' shops**  
offer a selection of Single Tickets and Day Tickets.

**Drivers of the Regiobuses and Train Staff**  
offer a selection of Single Tickets and prolongation of the validity of the Travelcards.

**Internet shops**  
offer a complete selection of Travelcards.

## What does IDS BK mean?

Public transport in Bratislava and its region has joined to form an integrated transport system called **Integrovaný dopravný systém v Bratislavskom kraji** – IDS BK. This means, that the transport system consists of all involved transport operators on the basis of common carriage and fare conditions. You can use the same travel ticket under the same conditions no matter whether you travel by tram, trolleybus or bus operated by **Dopravný podnik Bratislava** (DPB), or by **Slovak Lines** regional buses, as well as by trains of categories Osobný vlak (Os) (Local train) and Regionálny expres (REX) (Regional express) operated by **Železničná spoločnosť Slovensko** (ZSSK).

### Types of transport

	<b>Regional trains</b> run daily from 5am to 11pm (S25 has limited operation). Intervals starting from 15 min. during rush hours and up to 120 min. during the weekends.	<b>S20, S25, S50 and S60</b>
	<b>Trams</b> run daily from 5am to 11pm. During working days from 6am to 6pm at 8 min. intervals, rest of the time at 15 min. intervals.	<b>1 - 9</b>
	<b>City buses and trolleybuses</b> run daily from 5am to 11pm. The scale of transport and the intervals vary depending on the served locality.	<b>20 - 212</b>
	<b>Regional buses</b> run daily from 5am to 11pm. The scale of transport and the intervals vary depending on the served locality.	<b>215 - 799</b>
	<b>Night transport in Bratislava</b> run daily. Simultaneous departures from Hlavná stanica (Main station) are at 23.30, 0.00*, 0.30, 1.30, 2.30 and 3.30. All stops are on request. * only selected links	<b>N21 - N99</b>

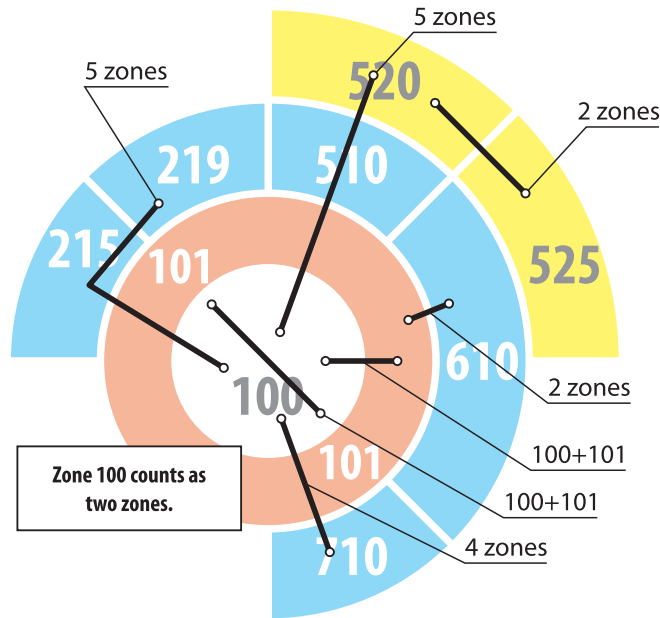


### Request stops

A **lot of stops** in the IDS BK are on request. The vehicle stops at these stops only if somebody wants to get on or off. **Before getting off** at a request stop you have to give a signal to the driver with the **button STOP**. When **getting on** at a request stop you have to stand on a visible place, so that the **driver can see you** in time. Even though it isn't compulsory, we advise you to signal to the driver your intention to get on by raising your hand.

## Fare system of IDS BK

The fare system of IDS BK is based on zones and time. The price of one travel ticket is derived from the number of zones and time needed for one journey. All the zones from the starting to the destination point are included in the calculation, including the ones your connection just passes through without stopping. Every zone is taken in account only once, even if you travel through it more times during one journey. You can change as many times as you like during one journey as long as its duration doesn't exceed the time your travelling ticket is valid for. The ticket becomes invalid after the time of its validity expires.



### Travelling around Bratislava

When travelling within the city boundaries of Bratislava (zones 100 and 101), it is enough for you **to watch the information about the time validity** of your travel ticket, since all types of ticket are valid in the whole of Bratislava regardless of their zone validity. You can choose a ticket with a 15, 30 or 60 minute validity. If this isn't enough, you can also use one of the Single tickets valid for a larger number of zones or you can select one from the selection of Day travelcards.

### Traveling around the region

When travelling around the Bratislava region you have to know the

**number of zones, or which zones** you will be travelling through. You can find the necessary information from the timetable or from the scheme of zones.

*Example:*

*When travelling from zone 520 to zone 525, the number of zones is calculated as 520+525=overall 2 zones. You can select for your journey a 2-zone travel ticket with a 15 or 30 minute validity depending on the duration of your planned journey.*

### Traveling from Bratislava to the region

When travelling between Bratislava and the region you have to know the **number of zones or which zones** you will be travelling through. You can find the necessary information from the timetable or from the scheme of zones. **Attention, the Bratislava zones 100 has a double price value. This means, that if you are travelling on a single ticket through zone 100, you have to count it twice in the final number of required zones. This exception is already taken into account in the case of other types of tickets.**

*Example:*

*When travelling from zone 100 through zones 101 and 215 to zone 219, the final number of zones is the result of adding up twice zone 100+101+215+219 = overall 5 zones. For this journey choose a 5 zone ticket with a 90 minute validity.*

*When travelling from zone 101 to zone 610, final number of zones is the result of adding 101+610 = overall 2 zones. For this journey choose a 2 zone ticket with a 15 or 30 minute validity depending on the duration of your journey.*

### Number of zones or predetermined zones?

In practice you can encounter two types of travel ticket. The tickets bought in advance have only the number of zones they are valid for indicated on them and their validity starts from the place where you stamp them. With a 3 zone ticket validated in zone 255 you can travel 3 zones in any direction. The tickets bought in the vehicle (exceptionally also tickets bought in advance) have directly on them the exact numbers of zones through which you can subsequently travel. For example, you can use a ticket valid for zones 235, 245 and 255 on a journey from Malacký to Láb.

A network tickets doesn't have a zone limitation which means that within its time validity you can travel in all zones of IDS BK.

## Single tickets, Day Tickets

**Single tickets** are valid for one journey on all lines including night ones and you can change with them between links as you wish. You can also make a return journey as long as you are within the validity of your ticket.

The validity is defined by a number or list of zones and by time. You can travel in the defined number of zones or in specified zones until the expiration of the time validity.

**Day Tickets** are valid on all lines including the night ones for an unlimited number of journeys.

They are offered for either just the zones 100+101, or for the whole network. If you are plannig to travel more times during one day, then this type of tickets is the best option for you.

## Karnet Ticket

**Karnet ticket** is a universal paper ticket designed for multiple use. The ticket has 24 fields (12 on each side) from which you have to stamp the right number of fields needed for your journey, according to the attached manual. You can use the Karnet on 2 to 8 journeys.

The procedure is easy. First you have to find out from the table how many fields you need for your journey and then count this number of fields from field number 1 or from the last stamped field. Fold the ticket before the field you need to stamp and validate it in the ticket validator. It isn't necessary to stamp every field, but only the last one.

If there are more of you travelling together, repeat the procedure for every person. If the number of fields ins't enough, you can combine two Karnets.

### To validate or not to validate?

You have to validate the tickets bought in advance from the ticket offices, as well as from ticket machines or from newagents' shops. You have to validate the ticket from these sources either before or immediately after you first enter the vehicle. In the vehicles of the city transport and in the Regiobuses the ticket validators are located by the entrance doors. When travelling by train you will find them directly on the platform as you approach the train. You don't need to validate the tickets which you bought immediately before the journey in the vehicle. This applies to all types of transport. These tickets have already indicated the time of their validity.
